

Future Judgments For Mankind Hebrews 9.27

Hebrews 9:27 - And as it is appointed unto men once to die, but after this the judgment:

1. The Bema – The Judgment Seat of Christ

2 Corinthians 5:8–11 - We are confident, I say, and willing rather to be absent from the body, and to be present with the Lord. ⁹Wherefore we labour, that, whether present or absent, we may be accepted of him. ¹⁰**For we must all appear before the judgment seat of Christ; that every one may receive the things done in his body, according to that he hath done, whether it be good or bad.**

¹¹Knowing therefore the terror of the Lord, we persuade men; but we are made manifest unto God; and I trust also are made manifest in your consciences.

2. The Judgment of Old Testament Saints – Mount Sinai

Ezekiel 11:17–21 - Therefore say, Thus saith the Lord GOD; **I will even gather you from the people, and assemble you out of the countries where ye have been scattered, and I will give you the land of Israel.** ¹⁸And they shall come thither, and they shall take away all the detestable things thereof and all the abominations thereof from thence. ¹⁹**And I will give them one heart, and I will put a new spirit within you;** and I will take the stony heart out of their flesh, and will give them an heart of flesh: ²⁰That they may walk in my statutes, and keep mine ordinances, and do them: **and they shall be my people, and I will be their God.** ²¹But as for them whose heart walketh after the heart of their detestable things and their abominations, **I will recompense their way upon their own heads, saith the Lord GOD.**

Ezekiel 37:21–28 - And say unto them, Thus saith the Lord GOD; **Behold, I will take the children of Israel from among the heathen, whither they be gone, and will gather them on every side, and bring them into their own land:** ²²And I will make them one nation in the land upon the mountains of Israel; **and one king shall be king to them all: and they shall be no more two nations,** neither shall they be divided into two kingdoms any more at all: ²³Neither shall they defile themselves any more with their idols, nor with their detestable things, nor with any of their transgressions: but I will save them out of all their dwellingplaces, wherein they have sinned, and will cleanse them: **so shall they be my people, and**

I will be their God. ²⁴ **And David my servant shall be king over them;** and they all shall have one shepherd: they shall also walk in my judgments, and observe my statutes, and do them. ²⁵ **And they shall dwell in the land that I have given unto Jacob my servant, wherein your fathers have dwelt; and they shall dwell therein, even they, and their children, and their children's children for ever: and my servant David shall be their prince for ever.** ²⁶ **Moreover I will make a covenant of peace with them; it shall be an everlasting covenant with them: and I will place them, and multiply them, and will set my sanctuary in the midst of them for evermore.** ²⁷ **My tabernacle also shall be with them: yea, I will be their God, and they shall be my people.** ²⁸ **And the heathen shall know that I the LORD do sanctify Israel, when my sanctuary shall be in the midst of them for evermore.**

Ezekiel 37:12–14 - Therefore prophesy and say unto them, Thus saith the Lord GOD; Behold, O my people, **I will open your graves, and cause you to come up out of your graves, and bring you into the land of Israel.** ¹³ *And ye shall know that I am the LORD, when I have opened your graves, O my people, and brought you up out of your graves,* ¹⁴ *And shall put my spirit in you, and ye shall live, and I shall place you in your own land:* then shall ye know that I the LORD have spoken it, and performed it, saith the LORD.

Ezekiel 37:21 - And say unto them, Thus saith the Lord GOD; **Behold, I will take the children of Israel from among the heathen, whither they be gone, and will gather them on every side, and bring them into their own land:**

This clearly must occur at the Second Advent. I believe as Christ returns and sets foot on Mount Sinai that He resurrects all of Israel and brings them to Judgment at that mount and then brings Israel into their promised land.

3. The Tribulation Martyrs (Rev 20.4-5)

Revelation 20:4–5 - And I saw thrones, and they sat upon them, **and judgment was given unto them:** and I saw the souls of them that were beheaded for the witness of Jesus, and for the word of God, and which had not worshipped the beast, neither his image, neither had received his mark upon their foreheads, or in their hands; **and they lived and reigned with Christ a thousand years.** ⁵ **But**

the rest of the dead lived not again until the thousand years were finished. This is the first resurrection.

Notice the Phrase, “This is the First Resurrection.” It is important to know that there is a resurrection in your future. Let it be the First Resurrection unto Judgment and eternal life. If it will be the Second Resurrection it will be for Judgment and Eternal Condemnation in a Lake of Fire and Brimstone for all eternity to come.

4. Judgment of the Nations (Joel 3.2)

*Joel 3:2 - I will also **gather all nations**, and will bring them down into the valley of Jehoshaphat, and will plead with them there for my people and for my heritage Israel, whom they have scattered among the nations, and parted my land.*

*Joel 3:9–16 - Proclaim ye this among the Gentiles; Prepare war, wake up the mighty men, **let all the men of war draw near; let them come up:** ¹⁰Beat your plowshares into swords, and your pruninghooks into spears: let the weak say, I am strong. ¹¹**Assemble yourselves, and come, all ye heathen, and gather yourselves together round about:** thither cause thy mighty ones to come down, O LORD. ¹²Let the heathen be wakened, and come up to the valley of Jehoshaphat: **for there will I sit to judge all the heathen round about.** ¹³Put ye in the sickle, for the harvest is ripe: come, get you down; for the press is full, the fats overflow; for their wickedness is great. ¹⁴**Multitudes, multitudes in the valley of decision: for the day of the LORD is near in the valley of decision.** ¹⁵The sun and the moon shall be darkened, and the stars shall withdraw their shining. ¹⁶The LORD also shall roar out of Zion, and utter his voice from Jerusalem; and the heavens and the earth shall shake: **but the LORD will be the hope of his people, and the strength of the children of Israel.***

*Zechariah 14:12–14 - And this shall be the plague wherewith the LORD will smite all the people that have fought against Jerusalem; **Their flesh shall consume away while they stand upon their feet, and their eyes shall consume away in their holes, and their tongue shall consume away in their mouth.** ¹³And it shall come to pass in that day, that a great tumult from the LORD shall be among them; and they shall lay hold every one on the hand of his neighbour, and his hand shall rise up against the hand of his neighbour. ¹⁴And Judah also shall*

fight at Jerusalem; and the wealth of all the heathen round about shall be gathered together, gold, and silver, and apparel, in great abundance

5. Millennial Judgment (Isa 2.1-5)

Isaiah 2:1–5 - The word that Isaiah the son of Amoz saw concerning Judah and Jerusalem.

²And it shall come to pass in the last days, that the mountain of the LORD'S house shall be established in the top of the mountains, and

shall be exalted above the hills; and all nations shall flow unto it. ³And many people shall go and say, Come ye, and let us go up to the mountain of the LORD, to the house of the God

of Jacob; and he will teach us of his ways, and we will walk in his paths: **for out of Zion shall go forth the law, and the word of the LORD from Jerusalem.** ⁴And **he shall judge among the nations, and shall rebuke many people:** and they shall beat their swords into plowshares, and their spears into pruninghooks: nation shall not lift up sword against nation, neither shall they learn war any more. ⁵O house of Jacob, come ye, and let us walk in the light of the LORD.

Psalm 96:13 - Before the LORD: for he cometh, **for he cometh to judge the earth:** he shall judge the world with righteousness, and the people with his truth.

Micah 4:3 - And he shall judge among many people, and rebuke strong nations afar off; and they shall beat their swords into plowshares, and their spears into pruninghooks: nation shall not lift up a sword against nation, neither shall they learn war any more.

Isaiah 60:17–18 - For brass I will bring gold, and for iron I will bring silver, and for wood brass, and for stones iron: I will also make thy officers peace, and thine exactors righteousness. **¹⁸Violence shall no more be heard in thy land,** wasting nor destruction within thy borders; but thou shalt call thy walls Salvation, and thy gates Praise.

6. The Great White Throne Judgment (Rev 20. 11-15)

Revelation 20:11–15 - And I saw a **great white throne,** and him that sat on it, from whose face the earth and the heaven fled away; and there was found no place for them. ¹²**And I saw the dead, small and great, stand before God;** and the

books were opened: and another book was opened, which is the book of life: and the dead were judged out of those things which were written in the books, according to their works. ¹³And the sea gave up the dead which were in it; and death and hell delivered up the dead which were in them: and they were judged every man according to their works. ¹⁴**And death and hell were cast into the lake of fire. This is the second death.** ¹⁵And whosoever was not found written in the book of life was cast into the lake of fire.

7. The Judgment Of All Judgments – Calvary

John 3:14–18 - And as Moses lifted up the serpent in the wilderness, **even so must the Son of man be lifted up:** ¹⁵That whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have eternal life. ¹⁶For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life. ¹⁷For God sent not his Son into the world to condemn the world; but that the world through him might be saved. ¹⁸He that believeth on him is not condemned: but he that believeth not is condemned already, because he hath not believed in the name of the only begotten Son of God.
