Psalm 12.6-7

Psalm 12:6–7 - *The words of the LORD are pure words: as silver tried in a furnace of earth, purified seven times. ⁷Thou shalt keep them, O LORD, thou shalt preserve them from this generation for ever.*

A. The Pure Word of God (vs 6) - *The words of the LORD are pure words: . . .*

We say that the Word of God is Inspired, inerrant, infallible, perfectly preserved, plenary, Word of God.

What do we mean by this statement?

- Inspired – The Word of God was breathed out by God and the penmen wrote.
- Inerrant – The Word of God has no errors in its content
- Infallible – There is nothing false in the Word of God the Word of God is always right and correct.
- Perfectly Preserved – The Word of God has been kept perfect by the mighty power and will of Almighty God.
- Plenary – Every Word, every Jot and Tittle, every cross on a “T” and every dot on an “i” was put in the Word Of God because God put it there.

For these reasons we should never change and never accept any change to the Word of God.

The World around us thinks the the possible changes in the Word of God are insignificant. Yet God has said,

Deuteronomy 4:1–2 - *Now therefore hearken, O Israel, unto the statutes and unto the judgments, which I teach you, for to do them, that ye may live, and go in and possess the land which the LORD God of your fathers giveth you. ²Ye shall not add unto the word which I command you, neither shall ye diminish ought from it, that ye may keep the commandments of the LORD your God which I command you.*

Proverbs 30:5–6 - *Every word of God is pure: he is a shield unto them that put their trust in him. ⁶Add thou not unto his words, lest he reprove thee, and thou be found a liar.*

Revelation 22:18–19 - *For I testify unto every man that heareth the words of the prophecy of this book, If any man shall add unto these things, God shall add unto him the plagues that are written in this book: ¹⁹And if any man shall take away from the words of the book of this prophecy, God shall take away his part out of the book of life, and out of the holy city, and from the things which are written in this book.*

This is what Almighty God thinks about our world's tendency to change and accept changes to the Word of God.

B. The Purged Word of God (vs 6) - *The words of the LORD are pure words: **as silver tried in a furnace of earth, purified seven times.***

The Word of God has been vehemently attack through the aged by the Devil, Kings and governments, atheists and even professed religious people.

Yet the Word of God stands perfect and sure still today.

1 Peter 1:23–25 - *Being born again, not of corruptible seed, but of incorruptible, **by the word of God, which liveth and abideth for ever.** ²⁴For all flesh is as grass, and all the glory of man as the flower of grass. The grass withereth, and the flower thereof falleth away: ²⁵**But the word of the Lord endureth for ever.** And this is the word which by the gospel is preached unto you.*

I recall hearing a testimony one time, I do not recall the name of the one who gave the testimony but what I recall is that they were under severe oppression and the were reading their Bible in a small group of Christians when oppressive government officials came in a caught them. The official burned their home and their Bible. When the fires burned down and the ashes settled they went in among the debris and found their a page of their Bible and it was these verses that had not burned.

2. Securely Preserved - Thou shalt keep them, O LORD, **thou shalt preserve them from this generation for ever.**

1 John 5:6–7 - *This is he that came by water and blood, even Jesus Christ; not by water only, but by water and blood. And it is the Spirit that beareth witness, because the Spirit is truth. ⁷For there are three that bear record in heaven, the Father, the Word, and the Holy Ghost: and these three are one.*

If God carefully and supernaturally preserved His precious Word for all generations then the Bible that was in the hands of the those severely persecuted by the Roman Catholic Church during the the dark ages when it was a capitol offense to have a Bible in your own home is the same Bible that God has preserved for our generation.
